

THE INSPIRATION

Located in front and around the "Trail House", as it is lovingly called by family and friends, CAMi Vineyards consists of two acres of Estate vineyards growing one half mile south of Larkmead Lane off the west side of the Silverado Trail. Purchased in 1999, CAMi Vineyards borders Selby Creek and Larkmead Vineyards to the West. This valley floor fruit grows the Three Palms Clone Merlot planted in 1996 on St. George root stock and 337 Clone Cabernet Sauvignon planted in 2006. Our DIVE Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of our Estate Vineyard as well as Cabernet Sauvignon from the neighboring parcel, located on the opposite side of Selby Creek on the Valley floor.

WINEMAKING

John Giannini is a terroir-driven winemaker, focusing on creating the best expression of the land. This wine spent 21 months in French oak, 90% of which was new. The wine is unfined and unfiltered.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

A full bodied classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon with hints of dusty cocoa and earthy tones. Ripe red fruit on the palate with balanced tannins and a bit of vanilla from oak aging. An approachable and elegant wine to drink now or cellar for up to 10 years.
