VINTAGE NOTES

A vintage for the history books, the 2020 season was like no other in the Napa Valley. Diligent care in the vineyards continued to proceed despite the global pandemic in full force. Further challenged by an unprecedented wildfire season in the Napa Valley, the 2020 harvest tested every wine-maker to the fullest. The temperatures were fortunately quite ideal throughout much of the season which allowed for great fruit and early harvest potential. Our Sauvignon Blanc fruit was harvested prior to any smoke damage could alter the quality of the harvest.

WINEMAKER NOTES

A blend of two single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc lots located in Rutherford and Pope Valley. The blend of these two sites produced an approachable and enjoyable summer white. Aromas of cantaloupe, white grapefruit, key lime pie and sautéed pineapple are immediately present on the nose. A medium-bodied wine with lively acidity and a juicy middle on the palate create a well-balanced and refreshing wine perfect for pairing with fresh summer cuisine.

BLEND: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

ALCOHOL: 13.4%

AGING: Fermented 85% in stainless steel and 15% in French oak barrels

PRODUCTION: 80 cases
